She received her high school diploma from Dunbar Senior High (Ft. Myers), Associate in Arts from Edison Community College (Ft. Myers), Bachelor of Arts with a minor in Journalism from the Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University (Tallahassee), Master of Science in Information Science from Nova Southeastern University (Dation at the conclusion of her tenure. She departed this life on October 30, 2021. GWM Carter was an authentic servant of God, a devout wife, and stout believer in the education of our youth.

- c. Official Letter of Acceptance from the school, indicating intended area of study.
- d. 500-word essay on the importance of your career choice and how you will use it to impact our society.
- e. 2 Letters of Recommendation (non-family members) on letterhead.
- f. Students receiving this scholarship are required to maintain a 2.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale. To continue the scholarship for the ensuing semester, the applicant must submit their official transcript.

First-Time Freshman

Eligibility Requirements for The Lillian L. Carter Scholarship for First-time Entering College Freshmen Students:

The total awarded amount per year is \$2,000 (\$1,000 for 2 semesters), up to 4 years, contingent upon the applicant meeting the required criteria. After successful completion of the Freshmen year, the applicant is automatically granted the scholarship at the Sophomore level, contingent upon maintaining the required criteria. - d. Official Letter of Acceptance from the College or University, indicating intended area of study.
- e. 3 Letters of Recommendation (non-family members) on letterhead.
- f. 750-word essay on how the Lillian L. Carter Scholarship will benefit you.



Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors

Eligibility Requirements for The Lillian L. Carter Scholarship for College Sophomore, Junior, and Senior Students:

This scholarship is for college students classified as sophomores, juniors, and seniors at a 4-year institution within the Jurisdiction of Florida. The total awarded amount per year is \$2,000 (\$1,000 for 2 semesters), up to 3 years, 2 years, and 1 year, respectively, contingent upon the applicant meeting the required criteria. After successful completion of the Sophomore and/or Junior year, the applicant is automatically granted the scholarship at the next academic classification, contingent upon maintaining the required criteria. To apply for this scholarship, please include the following:

- a. Complete application form
- b. Evidence of being a enrolled for the 2023 2024 academic year.
- c. Official College Transcript indicating a \geq 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale.

To continue the scholarship for the ensuing semester, the applicant must submit their official transcript.

- d. 3 Letters of Recommendation (non-family members) on letterhead.
- f. 750-word essay on how the Lillian L. Carter Scholarship will benefit you.



Eligibility Requirements for The Lillian L. Carter Scholarship for Graduate or Professional Students:

This scholarship is for students matriculating in a college graduate or post-professional college program at an institution within the Jurisdiction of Florida. The total awarded amount per year is \$3,000 (\$1,500 for 2 semesters), up to 2 years, contingent upon the applicant meeting the required criteria. After successful completion of the first year in the program, the applicant is automatically granted the scholarship for the second year, contingent upon maintaining the required criteria. To apply for this scholarship, please include the following:

- b. Evidence of being a graduate student for the 2023 2024 academic year.
